



Summary of the capability assessment

For the capability assessment the SZREDA team and the local working group use the methods described in the chapter for the capability assessment from the MiSRaR handbook.

The team made the research based on the three steps described in the chapter for the capability assessment in the handbook.

Capability identification;

Capability analysis;

Capability evaluation;

In the beginning of the report we provide general, theoretical, information about the importance and the necessity of the capability assessment.

Right after that we present the results from the “FTA” analysis, which were the identified measures necessary for improving the mitigation process in the region.

As a method for identification of the mitigation measures, the local partners provide a scheme with questions that facilitate the capability identification process.
